

Montejaque to Ronda

Walking - Moderate



This walk takes us from the small white village of Montejaque, nestled into a niche amongst rocky mountain peaks at the edge of the Sierra de Grazalema, to Ronda. We follow the original pathways that took villagers, drovers and their wares into the town in the days before cars, roads and railways.

We climb a stone "zigzag path" which takes us up and over the mountains, via a small chapel and a hidden plateau. We walk past huge agave cactus plants, olive groves and farms, with stunning views across the countryside all the way. Just outside Ronda we climb to a viewpoint from where the full drama of Ronda's position on top of a sheer rock wall lays before us. Dropping down into the fertile valley below the town, we walk directly below the walls of the gorge and beneath the Puente Nuevo bridge, before climbing to our finish point in one of Ronda's oldest districts, the Barrio San Francisco, which still retains much of its old village atmosphere.

Ascent: 376 metres
Descent: 352 metres
Max Alt: 749 metres
Start: Montejaque
Finish: Ronda

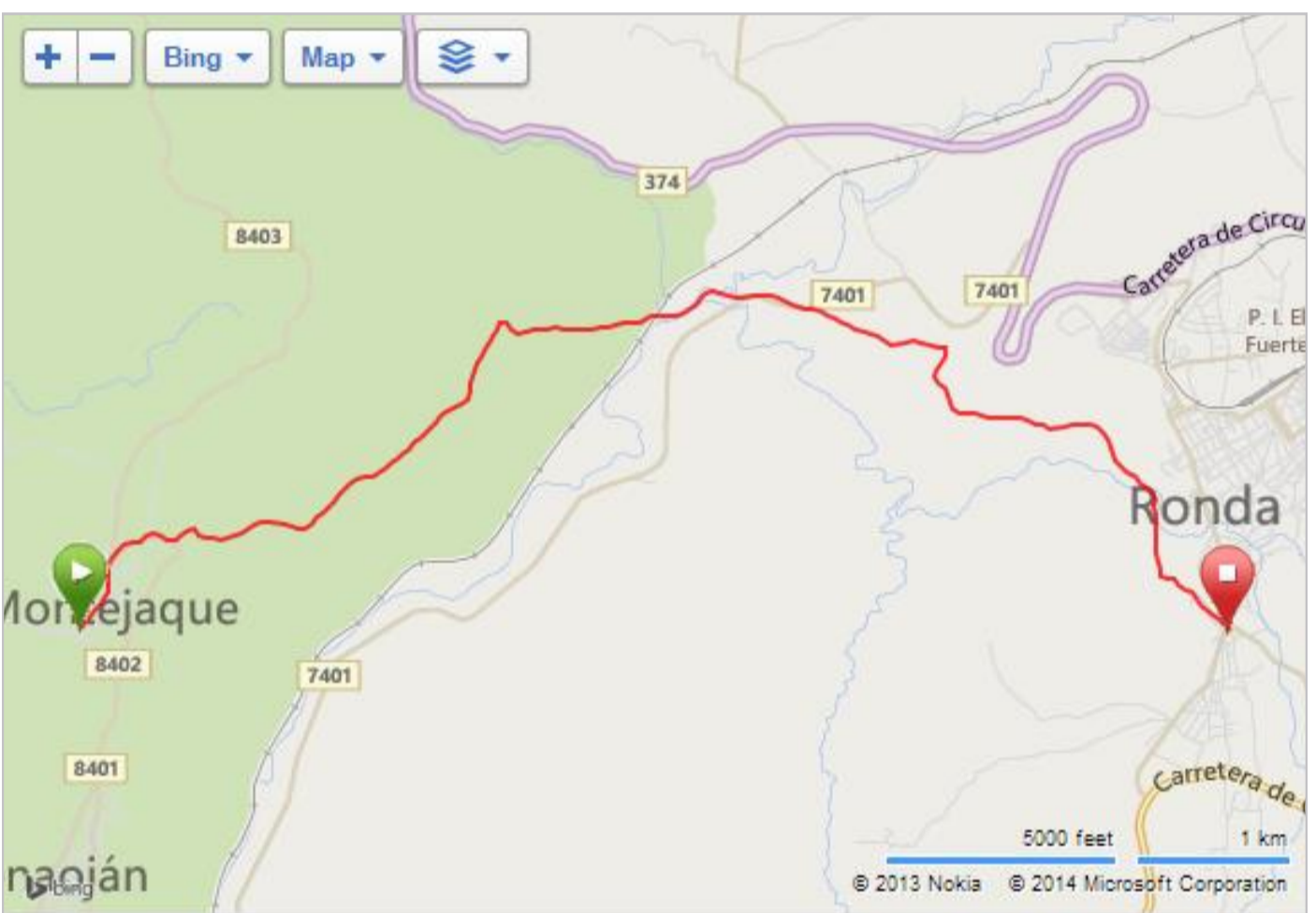
